UPDATES TO SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM MEALS, SITES, AND HOURS

The Warren County School District has been providing free grab-and-go breakfasts and lunches during the COVID-19 pandemic through the Summer Food Service Program. The district intends to continue offering these meals through the summer month. Declining numbers at some sites, however, have required the following modifications to the program:

- Beginning on Monday, June 8, 2020, Summer Food Service sites will be open on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday only.
- Each site will continue to provide both a grab-and-go breakfast and lunch for each child ages 18 and under for free.
- On Mondays, meals may be picked up for both Monday and Tuesday; on Wednesday for Wednesday and Thursday; and on Friday for Friday through Sunday.
 - The provision of meals through the weekend is a new service being implemented for the summer months.
- The following table lists the sites where summer meals may be picked up for children, as well as their hours. Everyone is encouraged to review the list for closures and/or hour changes.
