

**The Warren County School District  
2022 Summer School Program  
Middle Level Grades 6-8**

The Warren County School District is excited to be able to offer summer school this year at no cost. Summer school for middle school students will be available through the district's Virtual Academy and be done virtually. Courses will begin on June 13, 2022 and must be completed by July 29, 2022. The district will work with students on an individual basis if a laptop computer is needed. Cellular hotspots will not be provided.

All students that have **NOT** taken an online course should complete an orientation – a virtual orientation training course will be available on the student dashboard for all students. If you need further assistance, please contact our office for a training. Any questions regarding online courses or summer school can be referred to the Virtual Academy at (814) 723-0574.

Cost

There will NOT be any fee for ALL Summer School program courses during the Summer 2022 session.

Instruction

Students with non-passing grades in grades 6-8 will be offered the opportunity to complete coursework from the previous year's grade level to address learning gaps. These courses will not be for credit but will be used to address any potential gaps that may have occurred as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The instructor will meet with any student who needs additional help through Microsoft Teams virtual conferencing.

Transportation

No transportation will be provided as courses will be done virtually.

Registration and Eligibility

Registration forms are available and can be completed online. Forms can be found on the WCSD webpage and all district building webpages. Completed registration forms should be received by the morning of June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022. No applications will be accepted after June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022. If there are any obstacles to registering online, please call Laurie Maxwell at (814) 723-0574 ext. 1301 and she can help assist you with registering students.

Any student in grades 6-8 with a non-passing cumulative score in either a brick and mortar or virtual core content course is eligible to register for virtual summer courses.

Courses Available

Eligible students in grades 6-8 will be able to take a Virtual Course in Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and/or Social Studies for their previous grade level in which the course received a non-passing cumulative score. **If a student entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade is interested in registering for a course such as Health 9 for initial credit, they must complete the 9-12 Summer School Registration.**
