

WCSD Kindergarten Registration FAQ

Attention Parents and Guardians: Kindergarten registration is online, and we encourage you to register your child for kindergarten as soon as possible. In addition to registering your child online, you are invited to meet with your school and our related service providers!

How do I register my child for kindergarten?

- Registration is **ONLINE!** Go to www.wcsdpa.org and click on the Registration tab.
- On the registration page, you can:
 1. Watch videos about registration, transportation, nutrition, and more!
 2. Register your child for kindergarten.
 3. Upload supporting documents.

How old must my child be to attend kindergarten?

- Children must be five years old on or before July 1. No early admission to kindergarten is permitted.

What documents do I need to register my child?

- Each family registering a child for kindergarten will need to submit a copy of the following supporting documents:
 1. child's **state issued** birth certificate
 2. parent's proof of residency (child's primary residence) such as a utility bill, tax bill, mortgage bill, driver's license, or state issued ID card
 3. child's immunization record

What if I need help registering my child?

Can I meet with the school?

- Each school will host a Kindergarten Roundup session so interested parents can meet with various people to learn more about kindergarten and complete helpful screenings.
 1. Meet with the transportation department to discuss bussing.
 2. Meet with the school nurse to review medical needs and screening requirements. If possible, bring your child's immunization records.
 3. Meet with the occupational therapist, physical therapist, and/or speech & language pathologist.
 4. Meet with Nutrition to learn about the breakfast and lunch program.
 5. A computer station will be available for anyone unable to register from home.

Each school will host a Kindergarten Roundup session, with available parents, on the following dates.
